NARRANDERA WATER MAIN UPDATE

Narrandera Shire Council would like to advise that on Monday 15 January 2018 a major water main burst on the corner of Audley Street and Midgeon Street.

This caused major disruptions to the water main system reducing water pressure, while water was cut entirely from some Narrandera residents. Council's Water and Sewer department began works to repair the water main continuing to work through the night to restore water and water pressure to residents.

General Manager, George Cowan, advised residents "Please be aware that while water has been restored there may be issues with water quality and discolouration while the system is being flushed and the water flow returns to regular usage."

The East Street water main, at the Larmer Street intersection, also burst overnight while staff were fixing the original break. It will be repaired today (Tuesday 16 January 2018) and will cause interruptions for properties along East street, between Larmer Street and Bolton Street. This will occur for a short period of approximately four hours during the day. The intersection at East Street and Larmer Street is currently closed to prevent further damage, and will remain closed until the break is repaired and the road is reinstated.

Works will begin to clean up the site on Audley and Midgeon Street today. Therefore part of the road will still be closed until Wednesday when the excavation can be filled in.

Narrandera Shire Council appreciates the communities' patience while these urgent repairs are undertaken.
