## BARELLAN BECOMES LATEST RV FRIENDLY TOWN

Narrandera Shire Council recently welcomed an announcement by the Campervan and Motorhome Club of Australia (CMCA) that Barellan is the latest RV Friendly Town.

It follows the installation of a new septic dump point at the Barellan Hall and Barellan Showground, which was the final criteria Council had to meet for Barellan to become an RV Friendly Town under the CMCA's RV Friendly initiative.

The new Dump-Ezy station allows for easy unloading of waste straight from RVs and caravans to the septic system.

Narrandera Shire Council's General Manager George Cowan said "Recognition as an RV Friendly Town will help to boost tourism in Barellan. It will enable Barellan to be promoted through CMCA's channels and allow 'RV Friendly Town' signage to be installed in the town."

The CMCA is the largest RV Club in the southern hemisphere, with over 70,000 members. By becoming an RV Friendly town, Barellan now has access to CMCA's membership base to promote Barellan as a tourist destination not to be missed.

Mr Cowan continued, "Barellan's RV Friendly Town status will bring more tourists to Narrandera Shire and more visitors to the area means more money spent locally, which provides a boost for existing local businesses and encourages growth of the Shire."
