AERATOR TOWER PROJECT

Narrandera Shire Council has been working on the installation of a second Aeration Tower at the water treatment plant. The tower will work in conjunction with the first aerator tower which was installed and commissioned in 2014, to improve the quality of drinking water for the township.

The new \$190,000 Aeration Tower will treat water from Council's recently installed Bore 1 and Bore 3. The two Aeration towers have replaced the old in-tank diffusion aeration system.

Aeration is necessary to remove Hydrogen Sulphide and Carbon Dioxide gases from the bore water, as well as improve oxidation of Iron and Manganese. This process improves chlorine disinfection, producing safer water and will aid in water filtration in the future.

The Aerator project was finalised on 27th March 2018.
