WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION

Narrandera Shire Council is currently carrying out works to duplicate the rising water main along Oak Bank Street and Old Brewery Road as part of the upgrade of the water system network and to provide reliable water supply to residents.

In order to connect the new rising main to the existing system, Council must stop the flow of water in the rising main for a short period. This work is scheduled for Monday 4 June 2018 from 9am. The entire process of dewatering and connection is expected to take approximately four to six hours however could be up to eight hours.

Residents along Old Brewery Road, Robertson Street, some parts of Oak Bank Street, Lizard Drive, Norrison Road and parts of the Newell Highway will not have access to the water supply during this time.

The Brewery Flat public toilets will also be unavailable during this time.

Narrandera Shire Council would like to thank the Narrandera Community for their patience during this period and apologise for any inconvenience.
