BUSINESS BREAKFAST A GREAT SUCCESS!

Narrandera Shire Council kicked off Local Government Week Celebrations with a Business Breakfast in recognition of the Narrandera business community, hosted at the Narrandera Bowling Club on Tuesday morning this week.

The keynote for the breakfast was “We do what we can, with what we have, where we are,” there was a strong local presence of representatives from local business and industry, Mayor Kschenka, Councillors and senior Council staff together with Member for Cootamundra Steph Cooke.

General Manager, George Cowan, provided an update on Council’s activity aimed at driving Economic Development in the Shire, referring to the work being done behind the scenes to attract and support industry. He also referred to a Council visit to meat poultry produce Proten, noting it houses four million chickens and is the largest operation of its kind in the Southern Hemisphere.

Economic Development Manager, Peter Dale, also spoke, putting the focus on Council’s work to promote the Red Hill Industrial Estate through the recently launched Front and Centre Project. Attendees were given a viewing of four videos made to promote the Estate. The videos featured footage of the Estate and town and testimonials from the heads of BioAg, Patersons Transport and Hutchins Engineering. Copies of print collateral were also provided to the attendees.

The project was jointly funded by Council and the NSW Government through its Regional Growth Fund. Mr Dale noted that there are several prospective buyers for land at the Estate that Council is currently working with.

Member for Cootamundra Steph Cooke also attended and had some very positive words to say about Narrandera and the Shire in general.

Mayor Neville Kschenka said the breakfast provided an informal opportunity to bring business owners and Council together. “It was a positive event, giving business owners an insight into the advocacy work Council is doing, and the work being done on a number of very real opportunities that have opened up recently, “ said Cr Kschenka.
