Narrandera Shire Council will host a big breakfast event for local farmers at the Narrandera Football Club, Narrandera Sportsground at 8am on Tuesday 11 September.

All local farmers are invited to attend to enjoy a big bacon and egg roll BBQ prepared by the local footy club and after breakfast to join in a conversation with visiting Beyond Blue Ambassador, Paul Walshe.

This free-of -charge breakfast is the first of four Council sponsored drought assistance initiatives, with the Drought Assistance Bus visiting Grong Grong, Sandigo and Barellan next Wednesday, Thursday and Friday respectively (12-14 September).

Mayor Neville Kschenka said today that Council is delighted the NSW Department of Industry has given approval for the redeployment of the Business Connect Bus to attend rural locations in the Shire.

"The Department of Industry has bent over backwards to support this drought initiative to give practical assistance to farmers in need, at locations which are easy for them to access."

Council will also provide a free of charge BBQ at each of the events for farmers and members of drought affected rural communities in the Shire.

"The BBQs will be catered for by local groups at each location that the Business Connect Bus will travel to and expert business advisors knowledgeable in the Government's Drought Assistance packages will be on hand to provide useful information to farmers," Mayor Kschenka concluded.
