RSA OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG ADULTS IN THE COMMUNITY

Narrandera Shire Council is offering young adults in the community the opportunity to receive Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) training at a discounted price.

“This opportunity allows young people the chance to gain their RSA Certificate when they might not have been able to otherwise. Completion of the course can open up employment opportunities and in addition participants will learn about the dangers and consequences of drink driving,” said Elizabeth Mudford, Narrandera Shire Councils Road Safety Officer.

The aim of the RSA training is to educate young adults about:

- the legislation relating to the responsible service of alcohol in NSW
- the impact of alcohol abuse on families, communities and tax payers
- preventing intoxication, underage drinking and drink driving

The course is available to residents of Narrandera Shire aged between 17 and 25 years. Young people aged between 17-18 years old are able to complete the course and receive their certificates but are not able to be employed in all licenced premises until they are 18 years of age.

Narrandera Shire Council is offering the course at the discounted price of \$80 instead of the normal course fee of \$160.

The course is on Saturday 1 December in Narrandera at the Emergency Operations Centre.
