WELCOME SIGNS FOR NARRANDERA SHIRE

Residents and visitors travelling through Narrandera Shire will begin to see bright new signage popping up at boundary points, welcoming or farewelling all who come to the area.

Council's Economic Development team has overseen the design and construction of the signs that will be erected at 10 locations across the Shire. The process has included the design concept, determination of size, wording, colours, RMS approval, location and placement.

Mayor of Narrandera Cr Neville Kschenka said today that the implementation of this component of Council's signage strategy was very pleasing and would leave visitors to the Shire in no doubt as to the warm welcome awaiting them.

"These signs are visually pleasing and easy to read with a positive entry message - "Welcome to Narrandera Shire, Wiradjuri Country". The reverse stating "Thank you for visiting Narrandera Shire, Wiradjuri Country," Mayor Kschenka said.


Council's works team are progressively installing the signs at the following locations across the Shire:

1. Burley Griffin way-West of Binya-Carrathool/Narrandera border
2. Burley Griffin Way-East of Kamarah-Coolamon/Narrandera border
3. Newell Highway-Coolamon/Narrandera border
4. Canola Way-East of Grong Grong-Coolamon/Narrandera border
5. Sturt Highway-Wagga/Narrandera border
6. Lockhart Road-Lockhart/Narrandera border
7. Newell Highway-North of Morundah-Urana/Narrandera border
8. Sturt Highway-Murrumbidgee/Narrandera border
9. Irrigation Way-Leeton/Narrandera border
10. Kolkibertoo Road-Bland/Narrandera border

The installation of these signs follows a process of identifying and removing old and redundant signage that have been at various locations along Shire roads.

The next stage of the signage strategy is now in progress with designs to be submitted to Council in the near future for Narrandera town entry signs. The Mayor said that these signs would complement the boundary entry signs and ensure that all visitors feel welcomed to the Shire when visiting for business, tourism or leisure.
