HEADING ENERGY EFFICIENCY FOR SMALL BUSINESS COMING TO NARRANDERA

Narrandera Shire Council is set to welcome Moreland Energy Foundation (MELF) representative Jason Cox, to run a workshop focusing on energy efficiency for local business owners in the Shire.

Moreland Energy Foundation Ltd (MEFL) recently announced their partnership with the NSW Government to deliver eight workshops for small business throughout the Riverina from 1 to 5 April 2019.

Jason will deliver a one-hour workshop, having previously designed and delivered workshops for Small Business Victoria and has led small business programs for councils and not-for-profit organisations.

Mayor Neville Kschenka is encouraging any and all business owners to take advantage of this opportunity and find out what they can be doing to increase energy efficiency and decrease costs.

“As a small business owner myself, I understand how important it is for business, farmers and industry to know what is available and enable them to save on energy costs.”
