COMMUNITY LIAISON OFFICER APPOINTED BY COUNCIL

Narrandera Shire Council is pleased to announce the appointment of our Community Liaison Officer, Suzanne Litchfield.

This position will develop, implement, deliver and evaluate a range of programs, activities and policies to support the Council to identify emerging and current issues affecting the Youth and Indigenous sectors of the community.

This role will help Council promote partnerships and community engagement by developing links and fostering partnerships that encourage cooperation between community organisations and service providers.

Suz has already begun to facilitate the establishment of the Narrandera Youth Advisory Council, after an information session was held on Monday 27 May, 2019. This information evening was attended by 20 members of the youth community along with Councillors and Council staff. This session provided information about the functions of the Youth Advisory Council. Once appointed, Youth Council members will assist Suz in the development of the Youth Strategic Plan.
