WORKS OF ART FOR NARRANDERA WATER TOWER COMPLETED

Following two weeks of intense weather with strong winds, the artwork on the water tower is now completed. Using over 120 litres of paint applied to the murals and river that connects the two artworks, the outcome is an incredible sight to behold.

With the best view across town, visitors and residents will now be able to head to the water tower and immerse themselves in a visual collection of landmarks, activities, flora and fauna that resonates with our community.

Mayor Cr Neville Kschenka expects this will be an excellent opportunity to build on Narrandera Shire visitor experiences, “It is a great addition to the public art trail that is very popular with travellers.”

“I am very pleased with the artwork that has been created on the Narrandera water tower. There have been many residents eager to see this come to fruition over the years and now we have something we can all be proud of.”

A collection of five story boards will be installed further detailing the project including workshops, community involvement, themes and stories behind each of the icons, colouring, application practices and the history of the landmark.

The project also included new infrastructure with a new road, pedestrian footpath and a viewing area with accompanying seating. Parking is also available for all access to the site including a disabled parking space, four standard parking spaces and long vehicle parking along the side street.

This project is one of eight funded through the Federal Government’s Drought Communities Programme, completed before the deadline of 30 June 2019.
