## WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE NEXT?

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The NSW Government's Stronger Country Communities Program is now open for applications in round three and we want to hear from you about which projects you would like to see completed. Both Council and for the first time, community groups, can apply for projects.

This round focus on youth projects including the development of new or upgrades to existing infrastructure for young people and delivering programs for young people. These projects must be aligned to the areas of community, wellbeing, connectivity and work readiness.

General community amenity projects must be for the construction of new or upgrades to existing local community infrastructure, the construction of new or upgrades to existing local sporting infrastructure, capital works projects related to street beautification and other public places that promote the health, happiness and wellbeing of the community, delivering programs that benefit the local community and building infrastructure to assist the delivery of general community programs.

Council has put together a list of possible projects and are seeking community feedback.

### Narrandera

- Solar heating of Olympic Pool and slides
- Community Halls projects (Sandigo, Grong Grong, Kamarah, Binya)
- Upgrade the water tower area including equipment, landscaping, pump track
- \$50,000 towards Youth Advisory Council chosen projects
- Parkside Cottage Museum upgrades including accessibility and amenities
- Permanent stage at Marie Bashir Park
- Footbridge over railway line linking north Narrandera, approximately between Charles Street and Lady Lock Place

### Barellan

- Barellan Netball Courts
- Footpath connecting the Barellan Aged Care Units to the existing footpath network at the Barellan Ex-Serviceman's Club
- Skate Park
- Pump Track

### Grong Grong

- Hall upgrade including disabled access ramp, upgrade front stairs, upgrade mens toilets, air-condition for main hall
- Earth Park stage two
- Sportsground upgrade of canteen and amenities

Projects submitted must meet the guidelines and require a detailed listing of expected costing, designs including structural plans, impacts on the community and be valued at \$50,000 or more.
